For ARHA approved shows exhibitors, owners and horses must be registered with ARHA and present current ARHA membership card and ARHA registration certificate at time of entry.

Memberships and horses can join ARHA day of the show. There is a \$10.00 fee for expediting registration and membership taken day of show. Please provide a copy of your horses' breed papers with ARHA registration application.

All horse owners to provide a current negative coggins and rabies certificate.

All classes will be judged according to ARHA rules.

Judge's decision is final!

Scratches must be made 3 classes prior or no refunds will be given.

Show management reserves the right to divide, combine or cancel any classes at their discretion.

If there are less than 2 youth entered in a class, that class may be combined or cancelled.

If there are less than 3 open, novice or amateur entered in a class, that class might be combined or cancelled.

Horses should be shown as naturally as possible. No banded manes, hoof polish or silver halters. Tack should be working tack!

Western attire required for all classes: long sleeves, hat and boots.

To be eligible for HVRHA High Point, Versatility Day End Awards and Year End Awards All exhibitors must be current HVRHA members.

Versatility Award:

One horse and rider combination, must enter:

One (1) conformation class.

Two (2) non-cattle classes.

Two (2) cattle classes.

All classes must be declared at time of entry. Awarded in open, amateur and youth divisions.

To be eligible for Versatility Award you need to be a member of HRVHA

High Point Award:

One horse and rider combination. Awarded in open, amateur, novice and youth divisions. To be eligible for High Point Award you need to be a member of HRVHA.
