Office Charge: \$6.00 per horse

Stalls: \$25/day \$40/weekend \$10/day for unstalled horses

(there will be a stall charge for jump out horses if a stall is used)

All overnight horses must be stalled

Current Negative coggins required on all horses

out of state horses must present a current health certificate

*Western attire required for all classes: long sleeves, hat & boots

* Add or Dropped classes must be done two classes prior

*All classes will be judged according to ARHA rules.

*Horses should be shown as naturally as possible no banded manes, hoof polish or silver halters.

*Show Management reserves the right to combine classes.

*Judges decision final!
