GENERAL SHOW INFORMATION

All classes will be conducted according to the rules of the American Ranch Horse Association (ARHA). Horses/exhibitors do not have to pre-qualify to participate in this show. The management has made every effort to present the highest level of sportsmanship. Great care has been taken to select judges with a broad experience and knowledge of Ranch Horses. The judge's decision in the show ring are their own responsibility and the management accepts no responsibility for their decision. All exhibitors, owners, and agents shall be under the direction of the show management and Roberts Arena, Show officials, and/or directors shall not be responsible for loss or injury to any person, horse, tack or other personal items that are lost or in any way injured or damaged. Exhibitors, spectators and guests are required to protect their equipment. Please lock your trailers, vehicles and other personal items.

REGISTRATION & MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

All horses must be registered with the ARHA to compete in the 2011 World Championship Show. ARHA registration & memberships must be submitted with entries if not current. Either the original or a copy of the ARHA Registration Papers & current membership cards must be presented at show office before exhibitor's show packet can be picked up. If a membership&/or registration/transfer is not applied for by June 1st, a RUSH fee of \$10 will be charged. No transfers will be accepted at the show. All owners and exhibitors are required to be a current ARHA member. Youth and Amateurs are required to have a current division card to be eligible to compete in these division classes. No Youth can show in amateur classes. Youth classes are for exhibitors 18 & under as of January 1 of the current year.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

All horses are required to have current coggins/health papers. Out of state horses are required to have 30 day health papers. All Papers must be presented at show office before show packet can be picked up. Make sure the veterinarian uses the horse registered name on all health/coggins certificates rather than "barn name". If certificates are not available, the horse will not be allowed to compete and all entry fees will be forfeited. No exceptions.

VENDOR INFORMATION

Only Vendors that have paid for the privilege may sell or promote products for sale on the show grounds. In addition, the merchandise must be sold in designated vendor areas only. No items may be sold in parking lot or barns. Anyone found selling or promoting products to sell will be asked to leave the show grounds immediately with no recourse and no refunds of entry or stall fees. All of the ARHA Logos are copyrighted and cannot be reproduced.

STALLING INFORMATION

Every horse receiving a stall must be entered in the show or be a helping horse. Help horses are only allowed in roping and cutting. No more than one animal may occupy a stall. Anyone using an unassigned stall for grooming, storage or stalling of a horse will be charged for the full week stall fee for the use of that stall. Payment by check or credit card is required at time of entry. Reservations received without payment will be returned unprocessed. Payment is deposited upon receipt, but does not guarantee assignment to a requested stall area. All horses staying over night are required to have a stall- **absolutely** no over night tie-outs. Jump-out fee of \$25 per horse per day will be charged for all uninstalled horses. Horses may arrive on show grounds no earlier than Noon, Sunday, 7/17. Departure time from show grounds is 11 am on Sunday, 7/24. Contact ARHA Office for any special arrangements. Fans are allowed as long as all extension cords are secured and not on the ground. *Horses that do not show up by "date in" forfeit their stalls to ARHA World Show.* Any change on stall assignment must be made by Show Management. Stall assignment will be posted at the show office. Stalls may only be used to house horses and tack. Bedding is not included and may be purchased at show office.

GROUP STALLING

Persons wishing to stall together must submit entries in the same envelope, along with completed stall reservation form and full payment.

OPEN ARENAS

Arena A (Bradley Arena – rail horse only) and Arena B (Lamar Arena – cowhorse/reiners only) will be open 1 hour after the completion of the show until 6:30 am Monday-Saturday. No longing in any of the indoor arenas. Any other available times will be announced. There are also three (3) outdoor arenas.

HORSE/CLASS SUBSTITUTION

Horses entered in a particular class may move entry fee from one class to another class for the fee of \$10 per class, in addition the office charge on the new horse MUST be owned by the same owner as the scratched horse. All changes must be reported to the show office in writing three (3) classes prior to entering the area for judging. No exhibitor or horse changes will be accepted at the announcer's stand or warm-up arena. "No-show" entries WILL NOT be eligible for substitutions.

CANCELLATION OF ENTRIES

All entries canceled regardless of reason, will be handled in the following manner: Entries canceled through 6/1 - full refund of entry fee will be granted. Office fee will be retained by ARHA. Entries canceled 6/2 –6/14 - 75% refund of entry fee will be granted. Office fee will be retained. Entries canceled 6/15 - 6/28 - 50% refund of entry fee will be granted. Office fee will be retained. Entries canceled 6/29 - 7/8 - 25% refund of entry fee will be granted. Office fee will be retained. Entries canceled after 7/8- after the show begins, NO REFUNDS under any circumstances. Refunds sent 30 days from end of show.

SCRATCHING/WITHDRAWING FROM A CLASS

Please complete a Scratch Form at the show office BEFORE the class is called to the make-up pen. No one will be allowed to scratch at the gate. Any entry fees paid on that class would be forfeited.

SPLIT CLASSES

Any class deemed necessary by Show Staff will be split. All recalls will be announced by random order by exhibitor number and will retire to make-up area until called for final go.

CLASS CONFLICT

In the event that a horse/exhibitor has entered in 2 class in separate arenas that have a potential to be showing at the same time, please notify the Gate Steward. All attempts will be made to accommodate the conflict.

ALLEY & ARENA PROCEDURES

To avoid congestion, no persons other than contestants in the class, (team roping partners, herd holders & turn back help and the show officials) will be allowed in the arena, alley or make-up area during the judging. In conformation classes when changing horses, only one groom will be allowed per horse to bring the horse to the exhibitor in a previous class. No one but official show personnel will be allowed in the arena to take pictures or video tape classes.

"AT WILL" TRAIL CLASSES

All Trail will run on a sign up basis while the regular show is going on in the main arena. Sign up sheet will be at Show Office, sign-ups will begin at noon on Sunday, July 17th and will be on a first-come/first serve basis. 5-minute intervals will allow each exhibitor to show in their respective class between 7am-6pm at their convenience. If an exhibitor misses their time, they will be moved to the bottom of the run sheet. Exhibitors will be responsible for telling the judges/show officials the class number they are competing in and exhibitor number before they enter the arena.

RETURNED CHECKS

A \$50.00 penalty will be assessed for any returned check issued at the ARHA World Championship Show. The person(s) whose name and address appears on the check will be notified by U.S. mail and given ten (10) days to clear the account with a certified check or money order.

ADDING A CLASS

No entries will be added at gate. An entry form must be completed at show office. Individuals may add a class five classes before the class the exhibitor wishes to enter or a by 6:00 pm the day before the class if it is one of the first 5 classes at the start of the following day.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

Most important announcements will be made over barn's loud speaker, however, barn calls are a courtesy only, it is the exhibitors responsibility to be aware of class calls or schedule changes. All announcement request must be submitted in writing at the show office. The announcer's stand and the gate steward will be off limits except for authorized show personnel assign to that area.

EXHIBITOR/BACK NUMBERS

Entry numbers will be assigned to each horse, not the exhibitor. This number is to be used for all classes in which the horse is entered. Entry numbers in all performance classes except showmanship and in-hand trail, must be displayed on both sides of the saddle pad. Any entry entering the arena without a number or with the incorrect number will be disqualified. Exhibitors **must** use entry numbers assigned by ARHA World Championship Show (WCS). Replacement of exhibitor numbers will result in a \$20.00 charge.

TACK CHANGES

A maximum time period of three (3) minutes after class will be allowed for tack changes. All tack changes are to be made in makeup area. Once the gate is closed no contestant may enter the arena. **Tack changes must be pre-scheduled with Gate Steward.**

DOGS & PETS

Dogs must be on leash at all times on the show grounds and are not allowed in the building and/or show ring. They may NOT be tied in aisle of stalling area. Owner assumes all liability for pets and are required to clean up after them.

PHOTOGRAPHER & VIDEOGRAPHER

Only photographers and videographers under contact with the ARHA will be allowed to take photos or video any horse, exhibitor, owner, staff member or those associated with the ARHA World Show. Persons directly related to or associated with an exhibitor may take photos/video the exhibitor for personal use only but will not be allowed inside of the arena.

GATE RULE

All exhibitors are required to check in with gate steward one class prior, and once you have checked in you must stay in designated make-up area. A one minute gate rule will be enforced. Once the final call for class has been given, the gate will be closed in one (1) minute. No late participants will be accepted and no refunds will be given for missed classes. **It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be on the grounds and ready to show on the day of his/her scheduled classes without public notice.**

WORKING ORDER

All individual work classes will have a working order. The work order will be posted in the make-up area. Show management reserves the right to make changes as deemed necessary. If an exhibitor does not show up for their turn in working order, it will be considered a missed class and they will not be moved in order and will forfeit all entry fees.

TIMEOUTS/EQUIPMENT FAILURE

There will be no time outs for equipment failure. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be prepared for each class.

JUDGES

No one shall approach the judge at any time during the World Show. The show committee reserves the right to substitute a judge or change schedule assignment during show. In the case of a tie, ARHA Show Committee will randomly designate which judge will break the ties. There after judges will alternate tied classes. Judges & Show Committee's decision is final.

CLASS PLACINGS

During the 2011 ARHA World Show the announcer will announce up to ten placings under each judge, as well as the top ten placings for World Champion titles in all classes. Only World Show placings will line up for awards. Results of classes are considered final upon the receipt of the judges card unless an error on tabulation has occurred. ARHA reserves the right to correct obvious errors in judges cards when detected.

CLASS PATTERNS

Pattern books must be ordered with your world show entries. The cost is \$5 per book. Pattern books will be picked up at show office with exhibitor packets.

CHECKS TO WINNERS

Winning check will be mailed within 30 days of the last day of the show. No checks will be issued at show. All prize money will be paid by checks made payable to the recorded owner of the horse at time of class placings are awarded.

CANCELED CLASSES

Classes with less than 3 entries shown maybe canceled or split age classes with less than 6 entries will be combined in subsequent years.

CUTTING CLASSES

The show management reserves the right to pre-settle cattle in order to expedite the show schedule. Draw for all cutting classes will be held at 2:00 pm Sunday, 7/17. Horses entered after draw will be added at the end of work order.

WORLD SHOW TABULATIONS

Points will be tabulated on the following basis in classes that have more than one (1) entry for World Champion placings. **The points system below will only be used to calculate world placings and do not reflect the ARHA points earned.**

1st place = 55 pts • 2nd place = 45pts • 3rd place = 36pts • 4th place = 28 pts
• 5th place = 21pts • 6th place = 15 pts • 7th place = 10 pts
• 8th place = 6 pts • 9th place = 3pts • 10th place = 1pts

Horses will be judged under a Two-Judged System, with World Placings being determined by point values earned (above). Horses will be awarded ARHA points in each class and will be awarded under each judge's placing. No grand & reserve will be offered for any of the conformation classes. Results of classes are considered final upon receipt of judge's cards, unless an error in tabulation has occurred. ARHA reserves the right to correct obvious error on judge's cards when detected without recourse from exhibitor.
